The publication must be completed within 120 days of the formation of the LLC. After publication the newspapers will send you an Affidavit of Publication.

New York LLC Publication Requirements

Publication in a Newspaper. If the Judge grants your name change request, you will have to put a notice of the change of name in the newspaper chosen by the court. The newspaper charges a fee for this service. The signed Order will say that you have 60 days from the date of the order to put an ad in a newspaper (known as "publication").

Willis' almost total textbook analysis of today's newspaper makes *Surviving in the Newspaper Business* precisely what it claims to be: A how-to guide to newspaper management in the 1980s and beyond... a set of unified principles for successful management.' It explains the supervision and organization of each department and stresses the importance of keeping the paper responsive to the needs of its readers, advertisers and, somewhat surprisingly, even its employees. Willis talks about advertising, circulation and marketing strategies and how to deal with competition from TV, the suburban weeklies and labor unions. He believes that we have the tools to sustain high-quality journalism and preserve its unique social functions, though in a transformed way.
