The Heidelberg Catechism was written in Heidelberg at the request of Elector Frederick III, ruler of the most influential German province, the Palatinate, from 1559 to 1576. This pious Christian prince commissioned Zacharius Ursinus, twenty-eight years of age and professor of theology at the Heidelberg University, and Caspar Olevianus, twenty-six years old and Frederick's court preacher, to prepare a catechism for instructing the youth and for guiding pastors and teachers.

There are 129 Q&As in the Catechism, divided over 52 sections called Lord's Days. The common abbreviation for a Lord's Day is LD. After the first, introductory Lord's Day on the main theme of comfort, the Heidelberg Catechism is divided into three main parts: Our sin & misery (LD 2-4) Our deliverance from sin (LD 5-31)

The Heidelberg Catechism was compiled by Caspar Olevianus (1536–87) and Zacharias Ursinus (1534–83), at the request of the Elector Frederick III (1515–76) of the Palatinate. The Synod of Dort approved the Heidelberg Catechism in 1619, and the catechism has become one of four “standards of unity” that define the beliefs of the Reformed tradition .
